

## **Maintenance Tip - Rear Wheel Bearings**

*All K-F-D cars require special attention to properly grease the rear wheel bearings.*

*The routine maintenance of these bearings is often overlooked as there are no grease fittings. Directly above the rear axle tube at the outer-most edges at both ends you'll see a small metal plug with a slotted screwdriver head. This plug should be removed and a temporary grease zerk installed. Then grease the bearing through this zerk using **wheel bearing grease ONLY**. Do not use regular chassis lube. A couple of squirts is enough.*

*Do not over lubricate as the excess grease will likely run out onto your rear brake shoes resulting in brake failure.*

*Lubricate these bearings once a year or every 10,000 miles.*
